1 Kings 17:2-5a (NIV)

² Then the word of the LORD came to Elijah: ³ "Leave here, turn eastward and hide in the Kerith Ravine, east of the Jordan. ⁴ You will drink from the brook, and I have directed the ravens to supply you with food there." ⁵ So he did what the LORD had told him.

DISCUSSION

1. **Read 1 Kings 17:2-5a (NIV).** In this passage, we can see a pattern: Elijah's faith and obedience came before God's provision. How does our obedience play a part in receiving God's provision?
2. Share about a time when God supernaturally provided for you. What happened?
3. What is an area where you need God's provision right now? (This might be financial or something else.)

APPLICATION

Trusting God as our source requires faith and obedience. What are some practical ways for you trust God as your source and obey Him with your resources?

PRAYER

- Pray that each person would learn to trust God fully as his or her source.
- Take prayer requests and pray for any needs in the group.

CONNECT

Here are some fun ways your group can connect after the lesson or during the week.
