

Gloria

In 2019, Gloria found out she was expecting a child. She was experiencing fear and uncertainty about all the aspects of potentially becoming a single mother. Through the process, she decided to trust God with her pregnancy and raising her daughter. The pregnancy center that was helping her referred her to Milestone Church. She was then connected with Debbie, a member of Milestone who, through the generosity of our church family, put together a baby shower for Gloria and her daughter, to help meet any needs she had. Her daughter was born early, but Debbie insisted on showering her with gifts.

Gloria said the baby shower she received was, "Unlike anything I had experienced. A room full of Christian women who had a heart for God. and a heart for me." Debbie and the women of Milestone bought her everything she wanted on her registry, even a rocking chair! Roughly a year later, Debbie reached out again, inviting Gloria to Joy, our annual women's Christmas event. She loved it, and felt God moving through Milestone yet again. Gloria was attending a different church at the time, but felt like God was telling her to step out and look for something new. "I didn't want to simply feel the love of God, I wanted to show the love of God." Gloria said. She decided to volunteer for Serve Day. When praying about what project to be a part of, she saw there was a pregnancy center outreach.

"I wanted to do for someone else what was done for me—to show them there is light at the end of the tunnel, and that God is faithful."

That's exactly what Gloria had the opportunity to do! She gave back in the same way she had received 3 years earlier. Today, Gloria is a member at Milestone, and her daughter Alayna, and son Michael, love coming to church!





On the 2nd Saturday of each month, we have multiple teams serving to benefit our ministry partners and families in need throughout our region.

REFUGEES

We have opportunities to minister to refugees from multiple countries each month through a children's outreach on 2nd Saturday and food distribution on 4th Saturday. We also host holiday events for refugee families.

NEW NEIGHBORS

We deliver 150 welcome boxes each month to new families moving into our community. This is one of the most evangelistic opportunities we have through local outreach, and many families have come to faith through this simple act of kindness.

PEOPLE EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS

We provide food and other needed items to those experiencing homelessness each 2nd Saturday, as well as host special events throughout the year like a health fair, holiday events, and several projects on Serve Day.



COMMUNITY EVENTS

Each 2nd Saturday, we partner with various nonprofit organizations and ministry partners such as Christ's Haven and Community Storehouse to support their efforts to meet local needs.

SKILLED PROJECTS/ CAMPUS PROJECTS

We have a team of people with various skill sets that work together to assist single moms, widows, and the elderly with home projects. We also work around our campuses to assist with renovation and clean-up efforts.


SENIORS

Every 3rd Thursday, we provide dinner for lower income seniors at Evergreen Senior Center. In addition, we host a Thanksgiving Brunch and Christmas party each year and provide for many of their needs on Serve Day.

TRAVIS & LANDON

"There is something about serving that helps bring the Word to life. I didn't want to only model that life for my son, Landon, but let him experience it too, reinforcing 'You don't have to wait to be great.' We started with Serve Day, then welcome boxes, and now the hospitality/coffee team. These are all relatively simple, yet impactful missions which allow for both of us to serve others and grow spiritually. I've seen it in Landon already. During this last month of serving on the Welcome Box team, we had a ton of new kids there to help serve. I simply turned to Landon and said. 'You know how this all works. Can you be a leader for all these new kids? Show them what needs to be done.' He got right to work."

Christmas gifts were provided for





"Annalynne had lab work done last week, 48hr EEG testing tomorrow, and surgery Friday, with therapy 5 days a week, along with doctors appointments weekly with one of her many specialists. That is our daily life. Along with seizures, debilitating common colds, the pain tolerance she builds daily to offset the muscles, and joint soreness from her brain not being able to communicate with her body. Sadly, that's our normal. But last night we got to step away from all of that and live in a fairy tale. Princesses and princes who danced with Annalynne, music and many many children in similar situations were in attendance. It was a magical night! Cinderella even dropped a shoe and got to ride in a carriage. This all happened thanks to HopeKids and Milestone Church who created this event."

"Many years ago, when we joined HopeKids, we didn't really know what to expect. We knew they put on events for families such as ours (caring for kids with diagnoses, cancers, and life-threatening diseases), but the magnitude of family that we'd feel was nowhere in that initial feeling. Los Angeles Dream Center

March 6-11, 2023 Milestone College Students Only

Milestone College students will take a trip over Spring Break to serve at the LA Dream Center. They will be feeding those experiencing homelessness, ministering to people on skid row, participating in adopt-a-block programs, and doing evangelistic outreaches.





Guatemala

June 9-16, 2023 Ages 18-30

Milestone Young Adults will be participating in outreach and evangelism in the local community and area schools. We will also be providing humanitarian aid in the form of food and other needed items to families in the impoverished communities around town.





Fort Worth

June 22-25, 2023 Ages 10+ with Parent, 14+ without Parent

We will be ministering to refugees from many different countries, located right here in our own backyard. Our team will be doing individual home visits with refugee families, providing humanitarian relief with needed donations, doing individual men's, women's and children's outreaches, and culminating the week with a large festival. Our festival will have fun games and activities, as well as worship music and a clear presentation of the gospel.

Guatemala Medical/Dental/ Construction/Ministry

July 15-22, 2023 Ages 10+ with Parent, 15+ without Parent

This is a unique mission trip, as we will be taking 3 different teams, serving in the method they choose, all in the same location in Guatemala. This team was specifically chosen to allow families and/or spouses to experience a mission trip together but serve in different capacities should they choose to.

The ministry team will be working through local churches to serve the community through evangelism and humanitarian relief. We will also be working in schools and under-resourced rural areas to provide food and other needs they may have. Our team will also host church outreach events and have the opportunity to share the gospel with everyone we encounter.

The medical and dental team will be providing much needed care in a very underserved area.

The construction team will build 1-2 houses for widows and/or single moms.
